Information about Autism & the Foundation

Autism is a lifelong and potentially incapacitating disability appearing during the first three years of life. Autism impacts the normal development of the brain in the areas of socialization and speaking. A recent study showed 1 in 94 New Jersey children are diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders. The numbers are staggering: of the 212,000 school-aged children characterized as with disabilities, 6,400 were classified on the autistic spectrum. There is no cure for autism, but our best chance of enhancing these children's lives is through appropriate early intervention and school based programs.

This year's event will benefit the Drive for Autism Foundation, a public foundation that was established in 2004 by the Trezza family to distribute funds to not for profit groups that serve children with autism spectrum disorders. Previous recipients of grants have been the Union County Education Services Foundation, Crossroads School, The Children's Institute, Eden II/Genesis Programs, Morris Union Jointure Commission & Mother Francheska School. The children come from various counties in NJ and NY. The children in these programs typically have difficulty with speaking, interacting, and playing with others, and relating to the outside world. Autism prevents them from being schooled in regular classrooms in traditional classroom settings.
